CONSTRUCTION HAS BEGUN

Progress and Achievement Report—Guru Purnima 2009

Soon America will bring to fulfillment Maharishi's vision for an ideal home for the *Maharishi Purusha Program*—from which Purusha Silent Administration will create Invincibility for the 192 nations of the world. The Maharishi Purusha Capital is now being built in the Blue Ridge Mountains of West Virginia, facing east to Washington, D.C., less than 100 miles away (photo above shows eastern view).



Dr. Eike Hartmann (center), Global Country Minister of *Maharishi Vedic*SM Architecture and Dr. Roger Audet (left), Global Country Surveyor General, spent four months in West Virginia planning the Capital under Maharishi's direct guidance. Randall Ashelman (right), whose family developed West Virginia's famous 1300-acre Coolfont Resort, is the Project Manager, whom Maharishi appreciatively called "Mastermind".



Thanks to generous donors, 410 acres of perfect land have been purchased; engineering, architectural, and other site planning have been completed; and more than 6,000 feet of roads are under construction—all for a total cost of \$2.3 million. Now the first major building phase—for 120 residents—is starting, for which we require about \$10 million, some of which is already in hand.

When the Maharishi Purusha Capital is complete, the 192 countries of the world will each have one floor of a two-story residential building, including an Exhibition Hall and four residential suites—one each for the Purusha administrator, his two Computer Masters, and a National Representative. In total, more than 800 Purusha, guests, staff, and visiting course participants will be radiating from this powerhouse of North American invincibility.

The immediate target is to complete five residential buildings by year-end in order to welcome the first 40 residents.

Already \$1.4 million of the \$3 million needed to build these 40 residences has been conditionally arranged. The remaining \$1.6 million must be raised quickly if progress is to continue without delay.

A separately-financed Raja and guest residence building—for which donations have already been pledged—will also start when the road is complete.

Maharishi often said about this project
“We are creating Heaven on Earth,” and he urged us to do it quickly.
We have all taken this to heart in realizing Maharishi’s vision.
